

English Grade I Term 2 : 28-30 April

PLEASE NOTE THAT NO WORKSHEETS HAVE TO BE PRINTED OUT.
THEY CAN BE LOOKED AT AND ANSWERED ORALLY.

This work is for the whole week.

Oral:

1. Look at the rhyming words sheet and match the rhyming words. Discuss the fact that rhyming words END with the same sound like cat and hat.
2. Look at the little pictures about "When Mum Got Cross". Work out the correct order of the pictures and make up a story to explain what happened.

Reading:

1. Practise set 9. Revise all the set words and the row words.
2. Read the reading sheets "A New Dog" and "What a Bad Dog". Practise reading daily. Remember the more you practise the better you will read.

Phonics:

1. Practise all the alphabet sounds (page 1 in the homework folder).
2. Revise the 3 letter words on page 3 (folder).
3. Do spelling list 2 (page 5 in the homework folder). Practise sounding out the words and writing them on a piece of paper. You can also build them with your little letter cards. REMEMBER TO SOUND THE WORDS h-a-m = ham.
4. Watch the list 2 power point and sound out the words.
5. Use the worksheet with the missing middle letters to practise finding the middle sound in words. This can be done orally.

Writing:

1. Continue your news diary. Write a sentence about what you did and draw a little picture. (Once a week).
2. Write two simple sentences each day about your spelling list 2 words. For example: Sam has a red cap.

Handwriting:

Copy the letters from the dotted handwriting sheet. Remember to start at the black dot and to form the letters correctly.

This can be practised on paper.
