## Oral:

- I. Discuss your family and how people are related to one another. For example which granny is Mom's mom or Dad's mom? Use family vocabulary correctly such as aunty, uncle and cousin.
- 2. Answer the questions (orally) on the worksheet about Kipper and his family.

## Reading:

- 1. Practise set 7 and 8. Revise all the set words and the row words.
- 2. Read the reading sheets "The Toys' Party" and "New Trainers". Practise reading daily. Remember the more you practise the better you will read.

### Phonics:

- I. Practise all the alphabet sounds (page I in the homework folder).
- 2. Revise the 3 letter words on page 3 (folder).
- 3. Do spelling list I (page 5 in the homework folder). Practise sounding out the words and writing them on a piece of paper. You can also build them with your little letter cards.
- 4. Draw a big cat and write your "at" words in his tummy.
- 5. Use the worksheets with the missing first letters to practise finding the initial sound in words. This can be done orally.

# Writing:

- I. Begin a news diary. Write a sentence about what you did and draw a little picture. (Once a week).
- 2. Write two simple sentences each day about your spelling list I words. For example: I can pat the fat cat. / Dad has got a hat.

# Handwriting:

Copy the letters from the dotted handwriting sheet. Remember to start at the black

dot and to form the letters correctly. This can be practised on paper.

Do a little every day.
