<p><u>Utensils</u></p> <p>1 bowl 1 beater 1 frying pan</p> <p><u>Ingredients</u></p> <p>500g flour 1l milk 3 eggs 50g sugar</p>	<p><u>Method</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Sift the flour.2. Beat the eggs.3. Add the flour and sugar.4. Stir all ingredients together and stand the batter for 5 minutes.5. Fry in a hot frying pan.6. Serve with sugar and lemon juice.
