Activity 1: Improvising movement sequences

- 2. Explain the element of 'Space' in movement.
- 3. Explain the element of 'Force' in movement.
- 4. As a fun activity at home, do activity 3 (Create movement sequences) with your siblings or your parents. You may have 3 or more people in your group.

Activity 2: Music Notation

Learning to read and write music is very important during your next few years in the music subject so it is important to keep practicing.

- 1. In your classwork book, draw the stave and write down the letters of the notes on the lines and spaces. Remember that a stave consists of 5 lines and 4 spaces!
- 2. What is the note of the third line?
- 3. What is the note of the last space?
- 4. What is the rhyme we can use to help us remember the notes on the lines?
