
For the language section:

<u>Remember</u>:

Finite verbs have their own subjects; they can change tense and they can be either singular or plural.

How do we find out if a verb is a finite verb?

Ask who/what before your verb. If you get an answer (subject) then the verb is Finite.

Synonyms are words of similar meaning. Antonyms are words of opposite meaning.

<u>Remember:</u>

Literal language is the plain, ordinary use of language. Figurative language contains images such as word pictures, similes and metaphors.
