Activity 1: Music Notation

- Line notes: E; G; B; D; F.
 Space notes: F; A; C; E.
- 2. The note on the fourth line is D.
- 3. The note in the second space is A.
- 4. The word is 'FACE'.

Activity 2: The dotted note

- 1. A dotted note is a note that makes any other note 50% longer in duration.
- 2. A dotted crotchet is 1 and a half beats long. This is because the crotchet equals 1, we add half of 1 which is half. Therefore 1 + 0.5 = 1.5 beats.
- 3. A dotted minim is 3 beats long. This is because a minim equals 2, we add the half of 2 which is 1. Therefore 2 + 1 = 3 beats.
- 4. A dotted semi breve has 6 beats. A semi breve has 4 beats, so half of that is 2. Therefore 4 + 2 = 6 beats.

Dotted notes can become difficult and confusing just like any maths problem so make sure you keep revising this topic.
