Visual Art

 This activity is about the love that we have within a family and the importance of being kind to each other and how important a family is.

<u>Vocabulary:</u>

Direct family means the people who live in the same house as us. Dad, Mom, Sister, Brother.

<u>Instructions</u>

- Use an A4 blank page
- No need to type, writing will be sufficient, you can choose your own wording.
- 4 pieces of paper/cardboard, different colour for each member of the <u>direct</u> family, if you do not have access to cardboard, use plain white paper and colour in a different colour for each family member.
- Trace all hands of family members. Cut them out.
- Stick them on top of each other starting with the biggest hand first.
