South Africa is the second largest producer of gold. It is also the world's third largest coal exporter. South Africa also has a large agricultural sector and is a net exporter of farming products.

Chief exports include corn, diamonds, fruits, gold, metals and minerals, sugar, and wool.

Machinery and transportation equipment make up more than one-third of the value of the country's imports. Other imports include chemicals and manufactured goods.

South Africa imports motor vehicle parts, motor vehicles, refined petroleum products, televisions and radios and computers and office equipment.
