3. Reading: Read the following story about a little boy who cried wolf. (You have probably heard it before).

Wolf! Wolf!

Eenmaal was daar 'n seun. Hy was 'n skaapwagter (Shepherd – who looks after the sheep). **Hy neem elke dag die skape berg** (mountain) **toe. Hulle vreet** (graze) **die groen gras.**

Op 'n dag maak hy 'n grap (trick/joke) **en skree** (screamed) **vir die pret** (fun): “**Wolf! Wolf!**” **Hy dink** (thinks) **dis snaaks** (funny).

Al die mense (people) **hardloop** (run) **om die skaapwagter te help.** **Die seun lag toe lekker** (the boy laughed out loud). “**Hier is nie regtig 'n wolf nie!**” (There isn't really a wolf here)

Die mense is kwaad . (angry)

Hy doen dit weer en weer. (he did it again and again).

Die mense het opgehou om vir hom te luister. (people stopped listening to him). **Hulle weet hy jok.** (telling lies).

Eendag kom daar regtig 'n wolf! (one day there really was a wolf). **Die seun skree:** “**Wolf! Wolf! Wolf!**”

Niemand (No-one) **luister nie, want hulle dink hy jok.**

Die wolf vreet al die skape op. **Die seun is baie hartseer** (very sad). **Hy het sy les geleer!** (he learned his lesson).

 - 5 **Hoekom was die mense kwaad?** (Why were people angry at the boy?)
 - 6 **Hoekom het die mense nie na 'n paar keer nie vir hom geluister nie?** (Why did no-one listen to him after a while?)
 - 7 **Wat het aan die einde met die skape gebeur?** (what happened to the sheep in the end?)
