- Instructions are a list of things that order, direct or instruct us on **how** something must be done.
- ► They are written down in chronological order to complete an action.
- Instructions are written in the present tense.
- ▶ They should be simple, clear and easy to follow.
- They are precise and to the point.
- Instructions are written with an **imperative** (bossy) verb. They give an order or command.

Examples:

- 1. How to make a cup of tea.
- 2. How to braid your hair.
- 3. How to build a shelter.
- 4. How to bake bread on a stick.
- 5. How to build a raft.
