# Writing instructions

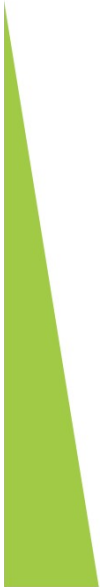
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## Instructions

- ▶ Instructions are a list of things that order, direct or instruct us on **how** something must be done.
- ▶ They are written down in chronological order to complete an action.
- ▶ Instructions are written in the present tense.
- ▶ They should be simple, clear and easy to follow.
- ▶ They are precise and to the point.
- ▶ Instructions are written with an **imperative (bossy) verb**. They give an order or command.

## Examples:

- 1.How to make a cup of tea.
- 2.How to braid your hair.
- 3.How to build a shelter.
- 4.How to bake bread on a stick.
- 5.How to build a raft.
