If I had a cat...

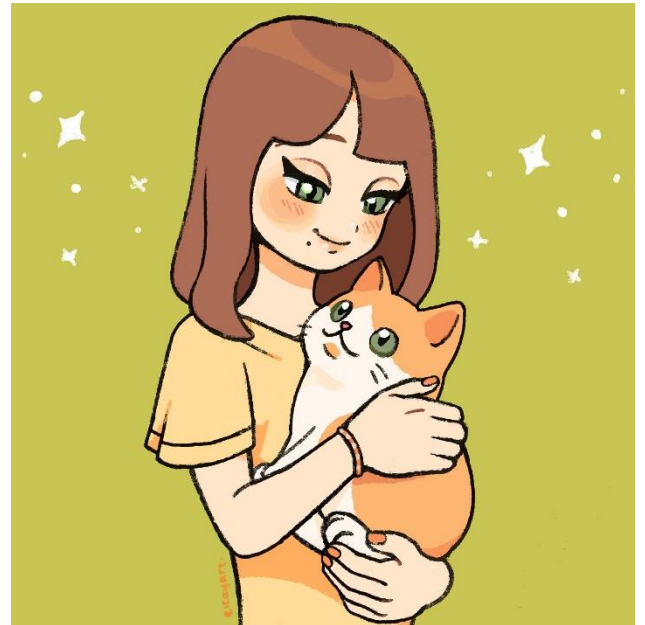

- What was the surprise in the story?

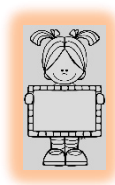

Cause and effect is when one thing (the cause) makes something else happen (the effect). Working out cause and effect will help you to understand what you read.

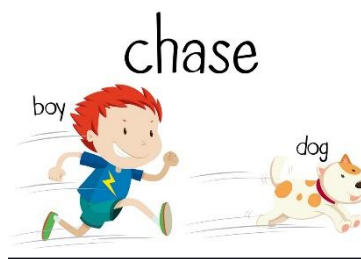
