Monday's work was to write two sentences for each season about the what happens to the plants and animals during each season.

Start each sentence with a capital letter, use commas where needed and end with a full stop.

I will give you a few examples, their sentences do not have to be the same as the examples.

Spring – During springtime the animals have their babies. The flowers are all in bloom and there are so many beautiful colours.

Summer – During summer the animals have lots of food to eat. The plants are growing, and we have lots of fruit and vegetables to eat.

Autumn – During autumn the animals start preparing for migration or hibernation. The leaves on the trees start changing colour from green to yellow, orange, red and brown.

Winter – During winter the animals are in hibernation and many have migrated somewhere warmer. The trees are bare and there is less fruit and vegetables to eat.

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Wednesday's work was to write five sentences about your favourite season and draw a picture of yourself in that season.

Start each sentence with a capital letter, use commas where needed and end with a full stop.
